HEART CHECK

TAKE A MOMENT TO BE REAL WITH GOD.

- When God doesn't act when I think He should, do I still choose to trust Him?
- Am I honest with Jesus about my grief, confusion, and disappointment?
- Do I believe Jesus is who He says He is — the Resurrection and the Life?
- Is my faith based on what I see, or on who Jesus is?
- Do I come to Jesus with my questions, or do I try to carry them alone?
- Am I living with the hope of eternal life, even in the hard seasons?
- What "stones" am I still waiting to see moved in my life?
- Is there an area where God seems late, but I need to choose faith today?



TRUTH TO REMEMBER

LET THESE TRUTHS ANCHOR YOUR HEART.

- Jesus sees your pain, and He is not indifferent (John 11:35).
- God's timing is never a sign of absence, but a part of a greater purpose (John 11:4).
- Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life (John 11:25).
- Everyone who believes in Him will live, even though they die (John 11:26).
- Faith isn't having all the answers — it's trusting who Jesus is.
- Grief and faith can exist together.
- The same Jesus who called Lazarus from the tomb still speaks today.
- Death is real, but it is not the end for those who belong to Christ.
- Our hope is not just a future event, but a living Savior.

Lord Jesus,
You see my tears, my questions, and my waiting.
Even when I don't understand Your timing,
I choose to trust Your heart.
You are the Resurrection and the Life,
