

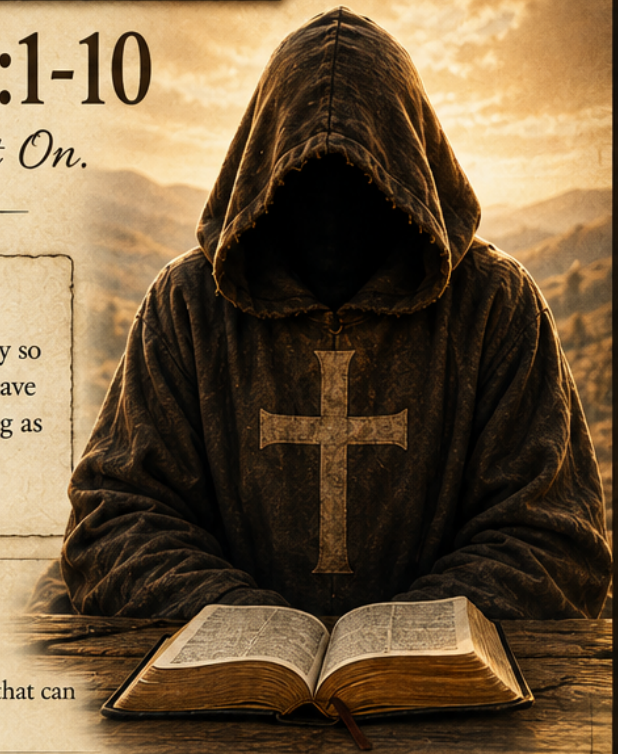
DEUTERONOMY 4:1-10

HEART CHECK



- ♥ Am I watching myself? Am I aware of the subtle drift that can happen when I stop paying attention to God?
- ♥ Do I remember what my eyes have seen? Have I forgotten how faithful God has been in my life?
- ♥ Is His faithfulness still in my heart? Or have I let it fade due to busyness, trials, or complacency?
- ♥ Am I holding fast to the LORD? Do I cling to Him with loyalty and trust, no matter what?
- ♥ Am I teaching the next generation? Do I intentionally tell my children, grandchildren, or others what God has done?
- ♥ Does my life show God's nearness to others? Is my obedience leading someone to want the God who is near?
