HEART CHECK

TAKE A MOMENT TO REFLECT. BE HONEST. LET GOD SEARCH YOUR HEART.

- 1 How do I respond when trials come? Do I grumble, or can I truly consider them a blessing in God's hands? (vv. 2-3)
- 2 Am I allowing perseverance to finish its work in me, or do I try to escape the process too soon? (v. 4)
- 3 Do I ask God for wisdom when I don't know what to do, and do I ask in faith, believing He gives generously? (v. 5)
- 4 Am I double-minded — wanting God's help but still holding on to my own way? (vv. 6-8)
- 5 Do I find my identity in my circumstances (rich or poor), or in my position as a beloved child of God? (vv. 9-11)
- 6 Am I persevering with a heart that truly loves the Lord, keeping my eyes on the crown of life? (v. 12)



KEY TRUTHS TO REMEMBER

- ✓ Trials are a part of the Christian life, but God uses them to produce perseverance. (vv. 2-3)
- ✓ Perseverance matures our faith and makes us more complete, lacking nothing. (v. 4)
- ✓ We can ask God for wisdom, and He gives generously without finding fault. (v. 5)
- ✓ A divided heart is unstable and easily swayed. (vv. 6-8)
- ✓ Earthly wealth and status are temporary; our true position is in Christ. (vv. 9-11)
- ✓ Blessed are those who persevere under trial, because the Lord has promised the crown of life to those who love Him. (v. 12)



TODAY'S CHALLENGE

When a trial comes today, pause and choose faith. Instead of asking, "Why me?" ask, "Lord, what are You growing in me?" Trust Him, seek His wisdom, and keep going.

*A steadfast heart today
leads to a crown tomorrow.*



A PRAYER

Lord, thank You for the truth in Your Word. Help me to see trials through Your eyes — not as punishment, but as opportunity for growth. When I don't know what to do, give me wisdom and help me to ask in faith. Remove any dividedness in my heart and make me steadfast, trusting You fully. Keep me from putting my hope in the temporary things of this world, and remind me that my true riches are found in You.
