HEART CHECK

Take time to honestly examine your heart
in light of 2 Timothy 4.



AM I LISTENING TO THE TRUTH — OR WHAT FEELS GOOD?

Do I seek teachers who tell me what I want
to hear, or do I welcome sound doctrine
that may challenge me? (2 Tim. 4:3–4)



AM I KEEPING MY HEAD IN ALL SITUATIONS?

Do I stay clearheaded and grounded when
life gets confusing, when fear rises, or when
the world drifts from truth? (2 Tim. 4:5)



AM I WILLING TO ENDURE HARDSHIP?

Do I shrink back when obedience is hard,
or am I trusting God to strengthen me to
keep going? (2 Tim. 4:5; Heb. 12:1)



AM I FAITHFULLY DOING THE WORK OF AN EVANGELIST?

Do I actively share the Gospel with others,
or have I become too comfortable or too
busy to tell others about Jesus? (2 Tim. 4:5)



AM I FINISHING THE ASSIGNMENT?

Am I faithfully discharging all the duties
of my ministry, or leaving things unfinished
in weariness, distraction, or discouragement?
(2 Tim. 4:5)



WHAT AM I LOVING MOST?

Do I long for Christ's appearing, or have
I begun to love this present world more
than I love His kingdom? (2 Tim. 4:8, 10)



WHEN PEOPLE FAIL ME, DO I REMEMBER WHO NEVER WILL?

Do I turn to the Lord who stands at my side,
or do I let disappointment harden my heart?
(2 Tim. 4:16–17)

*Their unfaithfulness does not excuse my unfaithfulness.
But You... stay faithful and finish the race.*

Lord Jesus,
Thank You for Your Word that is truth and for
the courage of Paul, who finished his race in faith.

Guard my heart and my ears.

Keep me from seeking teachers who tell me what I

You stand at my side and give me strength.
You will deliver me from every evil attack and bring
me safely to Your heavenly kingdom.

I look forward to Your appearing.

Keep my eyes fixed on Your return and the crown
of righteousness You promise to all who love You.

May I be found faithful when You call me home.
