What God Wants Me to Remember



My old self was crucified with Christ.
(Galatians 2:20; Romans 6:6)



Christ lives in me.
He is the source, center, and purpose of my new life. (Galatians 2:20)



I live by faith, not by work.
(Galatians 2:20; Ephesians 2:8-9)



I am loved by the Son of God.
(Galatians 2:20; Romans 5:8)



Grace—not law—is the foundation of the Gospel. (Galatians 2:21)



I am a new creation in Christ.
(2 Corinthians 5:17)



My life is hidden with Christ in God.
(Colossians 3:3)



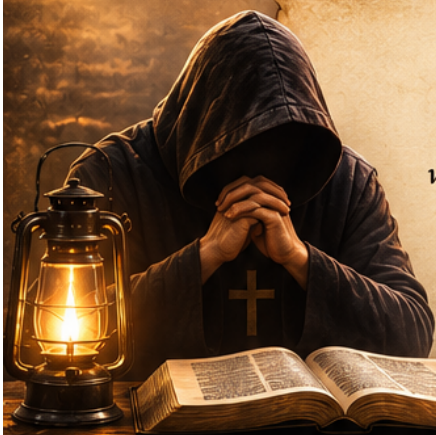
Because He lives in me, I can live the life God created me to live. (John 15:4-5)
