HEART CHECK

Honest Questions Before the Lord

- 1 Have I truly accepted the Master's invitation, or am I just familiar with it?
(Luke 14:16-17)
- 2 Are there good things in my life that have taken first place over the Kingdom?
(Luke 14:18-20, Matthew 6:33)
- 3 Do I make excuses when God calls me to step out in faith or obedience?
(Luke 14:18-20)
- 4 Am I more concerned with my plans, comfort, or security than with the Master's purposes?
(Luke 9:62)
- 5 Do I see the people around me who might be "on the roads and country lanes" — the overlooked, the hurting, the outsiders?
(Luke 14:21, 23)
- 6 Am I sharing the invitation with others?
(Matthew 28:19-20, Acts 1:8)
- 7 Do I live with urgency, knowing the invitation will not remain open forever?
(Luke 14:24)
- 8 Am I grateful that there is still room, and that grace is available for all who will come?
(Luke 14:22, Revelation 22:17)

where I need to realign my heart
with Your Kingdom.*
