HEART CHECK

Take time to be honest with the Lord.

- ♥ Am I waiting to feel brave before obeying something God has already told me?
- ♥ Do I look at the size of the enemy or the certainty of God's Word?
- ♥ Have I attached conditions or “if/then” limits to God's call in my life?
- ♥ Do I seek more reassurance from people than I do from God?
- ♥ What would I do differently today if I truly believed that God has already gone ahead of me?

Bring your heart before the Lord.

Thank You that You go before me.
You prepare the way, You fight my battles,
and You are with me always.

Forgive me for the times I hesitate after
You have spoken, or when I look for
reassurance from people before trusting
what You have said.

Strengthen my faith. Give me courage

my responsibility is to trust You, obey You,
and take the next step You place before me.

When I see iron chariots, remind me
of the God who commands the storm.
