THE LIONS

Represent the dangers, temptations, evil forces, and suffering in this fallen world.

1 Peter 5:8

THE DEN

Represents this world system that is opposed to God and His ways.

John 15:18–19

"If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first."



DANIEL'S PRAYER

Represents our steadfast faith, obedience, and daily communion with God.

GOD'S PROTECTION

God sends His angels, closes the lions' mouths, and surrounds us with His presence.
