HEART CHECK

Examine My Heart, Lord

- ♥ Am I truly seeking God's presence above comfort, control, or answers?
- ♥ Am I willing to let God teach me even while I wait?
- ♥ Do I trust God's character even when I can't yet see His plan?
- ♥ What would it look like for me to "wait on the Lord" today instead of trying to force an answer?
- ♥ Am I bringing my fears, hurts and worries honestly to God like David, or am I hiding them?
- ♥ Do I believe that I will see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living?
