HEART CHECK

TAKE A MOMENT TO BE HONEST BEFORE GOD.

1. Am I showing love in practical ways, not just in words?
2. Is my heart quick to judge, criticize, or accuse?
3. Do I sometimes let my feelings condemn me instead of bringing my struggles to God?
4. Am I trusting God's truth about me, or am I believing the lies of the enemy?
5. Am I living in a way that reflects my belief in Jesus?
6. Do I remain close to Him daily, abiding in His Word and Spirit?
7. Is there anyone I need to love, forgive, or reach out to today?

Thank You for Your great love and for the gift of Your Son, Jesus. Thank You that You are greater than my heart and You know everything. Search my heart today.
