WHERE IS MY FOCUS MOST OFTEN?

Am I looking at what is seen—circumstances, fears, problems? Lord, teach me to fix my eyes on what is unseen and eternal. 2 Corinthians 4:18



DO I TRULY BELIEVE WHAT YOU HAVE PROMISED?

You will raise me up, You are with me, and eternal glory is worth it all. Strengthen my faith and help me hold fast. 2 Corinthians 4:14, 17-18
