What do I rely on for peace, purpose, or worth instead of Jesus' Living Water?



3. AM I TRYING TO FILL A SPIRITUAL THIRST WITH TEMPORARY THINGS?

Do I expect lasting joy from things that were never meant to satisfy?



4. HAVE I ACCEPTED JESUS' LIVING WATER?

Have I truly invited Jesus to be the source of my life, or am I still trying to do it my way?



5. IS GOD'S SPIRIT OVERFLOWING INTO OTHER PEOPLE?

Am I living in a way that reflects the Living Water within me to those around me?
