HEART CHECK

- ♥ Do I truly believe He forgives me and does not impute my sin to me?
- ♥ Am I resting in God as my hiding place, or am I still seeking safety elsewhere?
- ♥ Am I willing to be instructed and guided by His eye, or do I resist and require correction?
- ♥ Is my heart following willingly, or do I need the "bit and bridle" removed from an area of my life?
- ♥ Am I walking in trust, or am I anxious about the path ahead?
- ♥ Is my heart glad in the Lord today?

Thank You that You forgive, cover, and do not impute my sin. I come to You honestly, laying down anything I've been hiding. You already know, but I choose to agree with You.

Thank You for being my hiding place — my refuge, my safety, my song of deliverance.
