HEART CHECK



AM I DEVOTED TO GOD'S WORD?

Do I make time to learn and grow through Scripture, like the early believers (v. 42)?



DO I VALUE FELLOWSHIP?

Am I investing in genuine relationships with other believers, or do I tend to live out my faith alone?



AM I MAKING ROOM AT MY TABLE?

Do I look for opportunities to share meals, life and encouragement with others?



IS MY HEART GLAD AND SINCERE?

Is my love for others real and authentic, or am I sometimes superficial or driven by pride?



AM I OPEN-HANDED?

Do I see the needs around me and respond with generosity, using what God has given me?



DO I TRUST GOD FOR THE GROWTH?

Am I faithful to plant, water, love and testify, and leave the results to God like Acts 2:47 and 1 Corinthians 3:6-7?

Thank You for the picture of the early believers in Acts 2:42-47. You didn't just save them — You gave them a new kind of life together.
